Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Suburban Cook County
- Must meet income guidelines listed above
- Must be able to provide documentation of need: bills, estimates for service, loss of income, etc.

Required Intake Documents:

- Driver's license, state ID, passport, or Matricula
- Social Security card for each member of household
- Proof of income for the previous 3 months prior to intake date (for all household members 18 years of age and older)
- Lease or Utility bill as proof of residence if ID does not match current address.
- SNAP/TANF award letter if applicable.

HELPING INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES



CEDA's Family Support And Community Engagement programs (FSACE) are funded by the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG). FSACE helps to stabilize and support families and individuals on a path to self-sufficiency. Services are available in communities across suburban Cook County.

FAMILY SUPPORT AND CASE MANAGEMENT

Program provides short-term case management services to families seeking financial assistance through other FSACE programs. Case management includes assessment of family needs, assists in the development of Family Action Plan, information and referrals, financial literacy, nutrition education and enrollment in other FSACE programs and services. Acting as your personal guide and coach, CEDA program specialists will help you set your step-by-step plan to a more stable future. Clients may be eligible for financial assistance to address other barriers. Any financial assistance will be paid directly to an approved provider.



FAMILY NUTRITION

To address food deserts in areas of Cook County suburbs, CSBG has partnered with the Greater Chicago Food Depository to purchase and deliver fresh produce twice per month to a variety of sites to distribute to CSBG-eligible families. A site list is available at www.chicagofoodbank.org

EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Provide job skills enhancements for unemployed FSACE participants through the services and expertise of a contracted service provider. Motivated eligible (FSACE) participants may get placement and support leading to permanent employment.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

FSACE scholarships are awarded to assist FSACE-eligible applicants with post-secondary education at accredited Illinois universities, colleges as a means to increase self-sufficiency. Scholarship applications will be available online beginning in April and must be submitted prior to the deadline to be considered for an award. Visit CEDA's web site. www.cedaorg.net

RENTAL 5GG-5B79

Program provides household budgeting and financial assistance for delinquent or 1st month's rent in order to maintain or achieve affordable housing. (Call to check availability of funds)

TRADE SKILLS

Program provides short-term case management and enrollment into trade skills training

DENTAL CARE ASSISTANCE

FSACE case management participants may apply for financial assistance to address dental issues to remove barriers to employment, education, training or health maintenance. Payment is made directly to FSACE approved dental care providers and a client contribution is required.

AUTO REPAIR ASSISTANCE

FSACE case management participants may apply for financial assistance for limited auto repair needs to remove barriers to employment, education, training or health maintenance. Payment is made directly to FSACE auto repair vendors and a client contribution is required.

VISION CARE ASSISTANCE

FSACE case management participants may apply for financial assistance for eye exams and glasses to remove barriers to employment, education/training or health maintenance. Eye exams and eye glass services must be by a FSACE approved eye care provider. Payment is made directly to the provider and a client contribution is required.
