



WIC: Women, Infants, and Children

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for WIC, you must either be pregnant; be breastfeeding; have had a baby in the past six months; or have a child or infant younger than five years old. You must also have a health or nutrition risk and meet income guidelines (185% of the poverty level). Parents, legal guardians or caretakers who have medical and financial responsibility for the child may apply for WIC benefits.
