The CEDA Dental Care Assistance Program provides financial support for a range of services—from preventive care to restorative treatments—ensuring residents can access the dental care they need to reclaim their health and independence, empowering our community one smile at a time.

Program Benefits

- **Preventive Care:** Routine exams, x-rays, and cleanings to maintain oral health and prevent future issues.
- **Basic Restorative Care:** Fillings and root canals to address dental issues before they escalate.
- **Major Restorative Care:** Crowns, bridges, dentures, and other critical treatments for significant dental challenges.
- **Prosthodontic Replacement:** Coverage for replacement and maintenance of dentures in extenuating circumstances.
- **Financial Accessibility:** Assistance of up to \$5,000 per household to cover essential dental care needs.

Our program provides financial support for preventive and restorative dental care, ensuring that individuals and families can maintain good oral health without financial hardship.

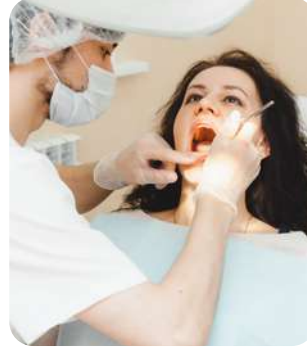

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a resident of suburban Cook County.
- Household income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).
- Provide proof of identity, such as a valid government-issued photo ID.
