Significant Changes to the IHWAP Field Guide – 2021

Section 500 – Health & Safety

Section 5051 Exhaust Only Ventilation

Copied efficacy value from SWS.

Fans must have an efficacy of 2.8 cfm/watt or more

Section 506 Kitchen Exhaust Fans

Added the following to meet SWS requirements.

Kitchen range hoods shall meet the following requirements.

- Maximum 3.0 sones
- Have a minimum efficacy of 2.8 cfm/watt

Section 507 Exhaust Fan Ducts

Modified the following based on the SWS.

Exhaust fan ducts extending through non-conditioned spaces shall have their joints sealed with UL 181B or 181B-M listed materials (e.g., mastic, tape).

Section 508 Dryer Venting

Increased the required R-value per the SWS:

Dryer vent ducts extending through non-conditioned spaces are to be insulated to a minimum R3 R8 (spray foam insulation may be used).

Section 510 Smoke Detectors

Added the following language:

Select battery-operated smoke alarms that are listed and labeled in accordance with UL 217 and have sealed, non-replaceable, 10-year batteries.

Section 5123 Specifications (CO alarms)

Added and modified the language.

- Must contain internal non-replaceable batteries.
- Have a five ten-year warranty from date of manufacture on the alarm and sensor. Expiration
 date, as warranted by the manufacturer, must be written on the front of the alarm in
 permanent ink.
